




meeting, we had a wonderful discussion as well as great time together. You are welcome whether you have read the book or just want to hear about it.

table next to the elevator, and add your name! This event will only be successful with your participation,


so plan to be here **October 20<sup>th</sup>** to share your talents and shop the tables of others. All proceeds go to the Abundant Grace fundraising budget.
